

# Where Our Heart Is

Canada's Joannie Rochette fought back tears for her entire heart-wrenching short program. When she finished, she couldn't hold back. Skating just two days after her mother's sudden death Rochette finished third in the short program at the Vancouver Winter Olympics. Afterward, she attributed her toughness and resolve to the love her mom was known for and had shared with her throughout her life. And this friends, is what I believe Jesus wants new normal Adventist churches like ours to be known for too—our love.

In order to do that, I suggest we filter our decision making through [at least] these three things: Building Families, Providing Hope, and Empowering Community [for more on each of these filters, please listen to, watch, or read my sermon "Where We're Going" from February 27, 2010 on our church website or pick up a copy of the Assimilation Manual at the church office or in the foyer]. The following is an example of how we're filtering.

Recently, a company approached us with an offer to purchase our cell tower for \$492k! That's a lot of money. But after numerous meetings, the church in business session followed the advice of the Finance Committee and declined the offer. They did so because we already receive over \$60k/year from cell phone companies renting bandwidth on our tower. The risk that we wouldn't continue to do so in the next ten years because of cell phone company mergers, or the likelihood of satellites taking over cell tower technology, wasn't deemed high enough. In the meantime, we love providing an excellent elementary school Christian education at a reasonable cost to the families in our church and community. And we will continue building families and providing hope through education since much of the money we receive from the cell tower goes to support our church school. Do you think we made the right choice?

# Order your quarterly. . . and other changes

In Pastor Mike's "Where Our Heart Is" article in the Jan/Feb 2010 Focal Point, he listed some of the cost saving measures the Finance Committee had discussed. In a followup January meeting, the Finance Committee looked at each item in the budget to see what could be cut back or eliminated.

Did you know we have been spending over \$1500 each quarter for Sabbath School printed materials? Beginning with the third quarter of 2010, those numbers will change. The church will no longer be purchasing adult quarterlies.

If your Sabbath School class uses a quarterly, here are three suggestions: **1. You can subscribe** and have your quarterly sent directly to your home for \$10 per year. To receive your quarterly for third quarter, you must order by May 17 by calling the ABC at 740.397.4675 or order online at adventistbookcenter.com. **2. You can download** your own quarterly or just read it online at <a href="http://absg.adventist.org/Standard.htm">http://absg.adventist.org/Standard.htm</a>. **3. Sign up** 

for a quarterly by contacting Dee at 419.882.6200 or email dee@toledofirstadventist.org. Cost is \$9 per year (4 issues). We must receive your order by March 23rd so we can add it to the church order. Please make payment by April 30. Mark your tithe envelope "SS Quarterly."

In addition to adult quarterlies, we have reduced the quantity of other periodicals as well, saving us \$600 per quarter.

To help with the cost of Sabbath School materials for our children and youth, your gifts in the Sabbath school class envelopes help. You may also give by using your tithe envelope and marking it "Sabbath School" under Local Church Offerings.
