Someone else some other time asked John Wesley, "What would you do if you knew you would die tonight?" He said,

"I would continue just as I had already planned for today."

We can have that kind of certainty in our Savior. But to have it, we have to have and maintain a relationship with the Savior! Which is something the weakest Christian can do.

One simple way to fuel that relationship with the Savior is to read the Bible. Not for research. But for a relationship. For Jesus is the Bread of Life [John 6:35]. No wonder Jesus prayed, "Give us this day our daily bread!"

So begin each session with prayer. Maybe something like this: "Lord, help me to come to know you better as we
