When we gather to give God glory, we're doing so on the day He created and uses to remind us of our recreation in Him. Just as He finished creation and rested on the 7th day, now our Creator is inviting us to rest in His finished work on the cross. That's one reason we should not neglect meeting together "as some are in the habit of doing." [Hebrews 10:25]

When we meet, another thing we could do is share what we've heard the Word say to us through our Jesus Journals. Get a notebook. Write the date and time at the top of the page each day. Underneath, write out the Daily Bite verse or verses you're reading that morning [Start with 2 or 3 verses. It's always Quality not Quantity!!!].



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Underneath that, divide the page into 4 sections.

In section one, answer the question: What do I like about these verses?

In section two, answer the question: What do I not like about these verses?

In section three, answer the question: What do these verses tell me about God?

In section four, answer the question: What does God want me to do about this today?

Remember, you're reading for a relationship not research! Normally, answering these questions will take you at least twice as long as it would reading the verses.

- Begin each session with prayer - maybe something like this: "Lord, help me to come to know you better as we spend time together..."
- Read the passage - several times noticing as many details as you can.
- Imagine the setting - put yourself in the picture. Try to imagine the sounds, smells, sensations.
- Answer the 4 Questions in each box.
