cage. Why? Because the other gift we want to give this Christmas is a "Bicycle Ambulance." Did you know that isolated rural communites overseas with a bicycle ambulance specifically equipped with a stretcher or bed on wheels can save lives? When every minute counts, when a woman is in labor or a serious injury occurs, this low-tech simple solution reduces villagers' travel time to the nearest medical center. So you will see a bicycle attached to a stretcher carrying a cage full of live chicks at church every Sabbath in December to help us remember that every gift has the power to change a life. And that this Christmas, we can help change the world one "peep" at a time.


Order fruit by noon NOV 2
