'Go quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and invite the poor the

Read this message from our Treasurer

Here is a summary of our finances the end of May 2014:

- We achieved our goal for the May Local Combined Budget - PTL! We had 5 weeks in May. We went over the proposed budget by \$494.19. Unfortunately, due to the severe winter, ongoing repairs, and current giving we are in the red for the budget - year to date, by \$9,708.50.
- 2. Our Tithe was up for May (primarily due to the 5th Sabbath this month), but alarmingly, we are continuing last year's trend of falling behind the previous year's tithe. So far in 2014, we have fallen behind 2013 by \$4,763.83. At some point the Ohio Conference may say we aren't generating enough tithe to pay a full-time pastor. That's the worst case scenario should tithe monies continue to decrease.
- 3. The Church Expense account is running in the red by \$12,467.68.
- Melissa Wurch, our daycare director, is still 4. keeping up to date on the JMLC \$1,200 monthly payment to church. Way to go and
- 5. Donna has been selling scrap soda pop cans to get enough funds to purchase more round tables for the Fellowship Hall. She now has \$568.74. Good job Donna! We should all help by donating our used cans.
